### Year One

This term we have really enjoyed learning about animals and in particular the different types of animal groups. Whilst learning we have been doing lots of sorting activities and using our reasoning skills to explain our decisions.

We have been looking closely at all the different lines and shapes that exist in Art. We have then used these skills, as well as paint mixing to sketch and paint our favourite animal prints.



In English we had a magical key left in our classroom. We wrote a fantasy story using adjectives to describe where we thought the key had come from and whom we thought the key belonged to.

We also introduced the children to multiplication and we have used lots of practical resources and drawing to help solve problems.

We are really looking forward to our trip to Marwell Zoo next half term.



## Year Two

We have enjoyed learning lots of new things this term.


We studied and compared different books by Roald Dahl. Whilst studying 'The Twits' we looked at how to write a character description using adjective and noun phrases. When reading 'George's Marvellous Medicine' the children used adverbs and exciting verbs to write a recipe for making their own potion! They completed this unit of work by writing their very own chapters.



The children have learnt about oceans and continents in our topic 'Around the World'. They have compared and contrasted different countries and looked at different cultures.

We focused on living things and habitats in Science, allowing the children to think about what being alive means. They have been identifying questions that we could ask to determine if something has been alive, has never been alive or was once alive.

In Maths we have consolidated partitioning as well as adding and subtracting using partitioning. We have learned about fractions of shapes, numbers and equivalent fractions. Mental Maths is an on going activity that the children practice every day.


