



Statutory Notice

Manby Lodge Community Infant School, Princes Road, Weybridge, Surrey KT13 9DA

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Surrey County Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to Manby Lodge Community Infant School, Princes Road, Weybridge, Surrey KT13 9DA.

It is proposed to enlarge the school by one form of entry (from two forms of entry to three forms of entry) to provide capacity for 270 pupils.

The proposed changes will take effect from September 2015. Manby Lodge Infant School, which currently has accommodation for up to 240 pupils, will be expanded to provide accommodation for up to 270 pupils. A building project will redevelop the site and new classrooms will be constructed on or near the existing school footprint making maximum possible provision for outdoor play space. Three forms of entry will be admitted in September 2015, and the two subsequent years; the school will be a full capacity three form entry infant school from September 2017.

There are currently 2 'bulge' classes in addition to the 2 forms of entry permanently accommodated; therefore the school currently has capacity for 240 pupils. The proposal will increase capacity permanently to 270 pupils. The published admissions number (PAN) will increase from 60 to 90 from September 2015.

All applicable statutory requirements to consult in connection with the proposals have been complied with. Surrey County Council will implement the proposal.

The proposal to expand the school is in response to the local demand for infant school places. It forms part of a borough wide expansion programme to provide a sufficiency of school places.

The transport arrangements for the schools will be in accordance with Surrey County Council's current school transport policy.
