### WHAT THE LEVELS MEAN

The results show achievement against the levels on the National Curriculum Scale. The scale is designed so a typical pupil will move up one level every two years.

Results in all subjects are based on the teacher assessment.

W represents children who are working towards level 1, but have not yet achieved the standards needed for level 1.

- School results for speaking and listening and science are based on teacher assessment only.
- A typical 7 year old is expected to achieve level 2B or Level 2
- Pupils who achieve level 3 are performing better than a typical 7 year old
- These assessments do not apply at every level and therefore figures may not total 100%
