Main Fundraising goals for remainder of the year	<p>Ideally we’d love to raise £15k to contribute or pay for these before the end of the school year. This term focuses	<p>26th Jan – Family Film Night and Pre-loved uniform sale.</p> <p>The plan is to hold this 4:30 – 6:15 in the school hall. A suggestion was made to try this with one-year group at a time (one film night per term). So, this event will be for Year 2 – we’ll see how it goes and take it from there. Due to licensing we won’t be able to advertise what the film is. You can buy a ticket which will enable entrance plus popcorn, hotdog and a drink. These will be £5 each.
