



Additionally they will enable us to use their estate agent boards to promote big events such as our Christmas Fair, Manby Fest etc.</p> <p>How the PTA will benefit the children over the coming year</p> <p>Miss Morris confirmed that the spend priorities are mainly focused on the hall and the ball court.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <u>The Ball Court</u>: The school will prepare a bid to obtain some funding towards the development of this space and some of the gated areas and grounds. Any funding we can provide towards this would be fantastic for the children to use. 2. <u>The Hall</u>: The only part of the school that wasn't touched by the build work was the hall. We have invested in the fabulous screens; the rest of the hall looks tired and in need of investment. This is another spend priority for us.
<p>Treasurers Report:</p>	<p>Profit totals raised</p> <p>Our target for the year was £17k. In total we raised £24,681</p> <p>The top line biggest fund raisers were;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Summer Ball £7,133 - Christmas Fair and Raffle £4,603 - Manby Fest £3,121 - Sponsored Manby Mile £2,334 (of which we donated £1,107 to Sports Relief) - Quiz Night £1,521 - Gift Aid reclaim for activities in 2017/2018 £1,524 <p>Total spent</p> <p>In 2017/18 we spent £19,975 on our children.</p> <p>Our largest spends were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Laptops, charging station and software £10,990 - Enrichment fund activities £2k - Hobgoblin theatre performance £798 - ICT Items £703 <p>The 2017/2018 accounts have now closed. These will be independently verified by an Accountancy Qualified professional and reported to the Charity Commission in advance of the deadline of June 2019.</p> <p>Current Balance</p> <p>We have a savings account contains £10k. This is being consolidated into our Charity business account held with HSBC. As of 1st August 2018 our main HSBC account had a balance of £7,672.</p>
