**Maths:-** In Maths this week we will be learning to measure capacity and volume using objects such as jugs and cylinders. We will be using the vocabulary 'full', 'empty', 'more than', 'less than' as well as 'half', 'half full' and 'half empty'.

**English:-** During book talk this week we will be reading the stories 'I Want My Hat Back' written by John Klassen and 'Can't You Sleep, Little Bear?' written by Martin Waddell. We will be looking at the questions in these books before using these in our own writing.

**Phonics:-** The children will be blending and segmenting words with **oy, ay, ou, air** and **ure**

**Topic:-** We will be continuing with our learning about The Great Fire of London.

### **At home you could:**

1. Look around your environment for question marks. Can you find any questions in the newspaper, a magazine, story books or anywhere else?
2. Practise measuring in the bath or a sink at home. You could use water bottles, plastic jugs and other containers.
