

Dear parents and carers,

English:- In Book Talk we will be revisiting internet safety. Together we'll be reading a story about a character that needs to make an important decision. We look forward to sharing some of the story with you during Shared Learning on 13th March!

In our writing, we'll be learning to use exclamation marks to show strong emotions.

Phonics:- In our phonics sessions, we'll be continuing to recap the phonemes we've learnt so far. Our provision will allow us to practise our blending skills whilst sorting 'real' and 'alien' words. We will also recap plurals, looking carefully at which words use 'es' (words that end in ch, sh, zz, ss, s, z) and which use 's'.

Maths:- In Maths we will measure small and large objects and begin to record lengths and heights using a variety of measuring equipment such as paper clips, cubes, hands, feet. We will be using vocabulary such as long/short, longer/shorter, tall/short, taller/shorter and double the size/half the size.

At home you could:

Ask your children to point out any exclamation marks in their reading books and make sure they use the appropriate expression when reading the sentences.

Measure large and small items in your home or in the garden.
