Dear Parents and Carers,

English:- In Book Talk we will be learning about the Human Body and our senses. We will be learning about the skeleton, muscles, heart, lungs and brain. We will also find different punctuation in our books and recap why and when to use capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks.

In our writing, we'll be labelling a human body and writing sentences using conjunctions and adjectives.

Phonics:- In our phonics sessions, we'll be continuing to recap the phonemes we've learnt so far. Our provision will allow us to practise our blending skills whilst sorting 'real' and 'alien' words.

Maths:- In Maths we will measure the weight of objects and begin to estimate, measure and record weight using cubes and grams. We will be using vocabulary such as heavy/light and heavier than/lighter than.

At home you could:

1. Find different punctuation in your reading books and discuss why the author has used them.
2. Estimate and weigh different ingredients when cooking.
