Our focus this week: - We will be talking about Mother's Day and how to say thank you to people that look after us at home. We will be updating our special books with photos of our learning. We will continue to talk about healthy and less healthy foods and how important it is to eat a balanced diet.

<u>Maths:-</u> We will be learning about doubling single digit numbers. E.g. double 2 is 4. We will be using dominoes and finger painting to help us learn about doubling.

<u>Literacy:-</u> We will be sharing and discussing recipes. We will use recipes to make our scones for Tuesday afternoon.

<u>Phonics:-</u> In phonics this week we are continuing to revise phase 3, revising the diagraphs ur, ow, oi, trigraphs ear and air. We will continue to revise the tricky words: I, go, to, no, the, he, she, we, be, you, are, was, my, they, her, all.

At home you could: Share recipes with your child and talk about how to use them.
