Welcome back! We hope that you all had a restful but enjoyable Easter Holiday! This year has flown by and we can't quite believe that it's the summer term already. Thank you, as always, for your on-going support.



English:- This week we will be learning about the prefix 'un'. During the week we will be relating it to our Jigsaw (PSHCE) topic 'relationships' whilst talking about being 'unfriendly' and 'unkind'. The children will then have an opportunity to use 'un' in their own writing.

Phonics:- In phonics we will be learning to add sound buttons to polysyllabic words and words that include split digraphs.

Maths:- We will be learning to use fact families to solve missing number problems. For example if $3+4=7$, what is the missing number in $4+_=7$?

Topic:- We will be starting our 'Ready, Steady, Grow' topic by asking questions about plants, trees and flowers as well as sharing the facts that we already know.

At home you could:

- Go on a walk: What do you notice about the trees, plants and flowers around you? Can you name any of the parts of the flowers you see?
- Search for the prefix 'un' in text at home. Can you make a list of the words that you find? What do they mean? Can you use them in a sentence or use them to write your own story?
