English:- This week we will be learning to recognise the features of traditional tales also known as fairy tales. The children will be learning about the characters, themes and settings of these types of stories. They will then learn to recite a shortened version of "The Three Little Bears" using actions to support them.

Phonics:- In phonics we will be recapping split digraphs. We will also be practising reading and writing words that use 'c' as 's' such as 'Bruce' and 'twice'.

Maths:- We will be learning to solve multiplication problems using arrays and writing the coordinating multiplication calculation. We will then discuss how these three numbers can be used to make two different multiplication calculations.

Example: $2 \times 4 = 8$ or $4 \times 2 = 8$.



Topic:- We will continue with our 'Ready, Steady, Grow' topic by planting seeds and experimenting with the different conditions required to successfully grow them.

At home you could:

- Read or share some traditional tales. You could visit the library to find some, listen online at BBC Radio or perhaps you already have some at home.
- Practise counting in 2s, 5s or 10s. How high can you count? You might like to group various objects to help you (pairs of socks, petals on flowers or toes on feet!)
