Dear parents and carers,

English:- This week we will be learning about plurals whilst reading the story of Noah's Ark. We will be learning to add the suffix **-s** and **-es** to various words to create groups. For example: cat - cats, fox - foxes.

Phonics:- In phonics we will be revising blending and segmenting real and alien words.

Maths:- Our Maths focus this week is to use time vocabulary. Whilst racing windup toys in the classroom and in the water tray outside we will try to use the words 'quicker', 'slower', 'earlier' and 'later'. We will also read the story of 'What's the Time, Mr Wolf?' and recap o'clock and half past.

Topic:- We will be continuing with our 'Ready, Steady, Grow' topic by identifying different dress and flowers around the school grounds. We will also continue to look after our sunflowers by watering them regularly.

PSHE:- This week we will continue our learning about Relationships.

At home you could:

- Look around for familiar trees and flowers. Can you spot an oak tree? How can you tell that it is an oak tree?
- Practise using the vocabulary 'earlier' and 'later', 'quicker' and 'slower'. Can you try to get dressed in the mornings 'quicker' than the day before? Could you time yourselves? Do you get dressed quicker for school or quicker for bed at night?
