Dear parents and carers,

**English:-** This week in English we will be reading non-fiction texts about different countries. We will learn that all names need a capital letter. We will be writing the pronoun I, any person's name and the name of a place using capital letters.

**Phonics:-** In phonics we will be revising blending real and alien words with split digraphs in, **a\_e** (rake), **e\_e** (complete), **i\_e** (mine), **o\_e** (cone), **u\_e** (cube and flute). We will also focus on the softening of the c when in the middle of a split digraph (e.g. rice).

**Maths:-** We will start the week by partitioning any one or two digit numbers using resources or drawing the tens and ones, e.g.  $24 = 11 + 13$ . We will then continue the week by using our tens and ones to add numbers together.

**Topic:-** We will be starting our Geography topic and recapping the continents and learning about the oceans. We are looking forward to International Week next week where each class will learn about a different country.

**PSHE:-** This week we will continue learning about how we change as we get older with the topic 'Changing Me'.

**At home you could:**

- Talk to your grown up about how you have changed since being a toddler. Where you in control of these changes?
- Find digraphs in your reading book. Are there any other digraphs which make the same phoneme/sound? Do you notice any patterns?
