



Dear parents and carers,

English:- This week we will be starting to learn the story 'My Grandpa is Amazing!' written by Nick Butterworth and the children will also have the opportunity to write about somebody in their lives that they think is 'amazing'. We will be using a thesaurus to look up exciting adjectives to describe these people.

Phonics:- We will be recapping the suffixes -er and -est (e.g. lighter/ strongest). We will also be learning to use apostrophes for contractions (e.g. we're/ don't).

Maths:- We will be learning to subtract 1 and 2 digit numbers using partitioning to support. For example: $53-21=32$

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Topic:- In Geography, we will be learning about the United Kingdom and comparing it to the different countries that we learnt about during International Week. We will also learn about our local area and the human and physical features that can be found around Weybridge.

PSHE:- This week we will be learning about the physical differences between boys and girls and learning the correct words for these different body parts. We will also review 'Pantosaurus', from the NSPCC, that children learnt about last year when they were in Reception.
