English - This week in English we will, excitingly, be acting out our very own wedding. We will be incorporating a range of different traditions. After acting out our very own wedding, the children will be using this experience to produce a piece of recount writing. Children will be including - headings, sub-headings, conjunctions, suffixes and a range of punctuation.

RE - During our RE lessons this week we will be continuing to learn all about weddings. We will be thinking about wedding ceremonies and traditions from different religions.
