Dear Parent/Carer,

English - This week in English we will excitingly be thinking about our leaver's assembly. We will begin our preparations by looking at examples of invitations before writing our own. We will end the week designing and making information posters to advertise our leaver's assembly to a wider audience.

Maths - In Maths this week we will be recapping our learning on solving word problems using the RUCSAC method. Children will be solving problems involving all four of the main operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

RE - During our RE lessons this week we will be continuing to learn all about weddings. It has been a very popular topic! This week we will be thinking about wedding ceremonies and traditions from Islamic and Indian weddings.
