

Our focus this week:- We are looking forward to welcoming families to our Shared Learning. We will be talking about what it means to be a good friend. We will be working in our craft areas practising our scissor skills.

Maths:- We will be naming and describing 2d and 3d shapes. We will be using the vocabulary: square, circle, oblong, cube, cuboid, cone, cylinder.

Literacy:- We will be encouraging the children to make predictions in stories that we share and the children will be practising their segmenting skills through our small world, role play, story corners and model building.

Phonics:- In phonics we will be continuing work on phase 4 which incorporates phase 2 and phase 3 phonemes, digraphs and trigraphs which we have already learnt. We will continue to practise the tricky words: **I, no, go, to, the, he, she, we, be, me, you, they, all, was, my, they, said, so, have, like, some, come.**

At home you could:- Look for and describe different shapes that you see around you when out and about. You could take photos interesting shapes that you find to bring in to share and talk about in class.
