English:- This week we will be writing up our edited version of the story 'My Grandpa is Amazing!' There are some really lovely stories that we can't wait for you to read. We will also be creating invitations ahead of our Grandparents Tea party as well as writing a list of questions that we hope to ask our guests about their childhoods.

Phonics:- We will be recapping the sounds we have learnt so far as well as the suffix 'ing'. We will also be looking carefully at some of our Year 1 common exception words and the days of the week. It's important to know how to spell these words correctly so we'll be looking at the 'tricky' spellings within them.

Maths:- Our Maths focus is number. We will be recapping lots of different number topics including correctly identifying 'most' and 'least', estimating amounts and identifying one more and one less than a given number.

Topic:- We will be beginning to think about 'Changes within living memory' ahead of our exciting Grandparents Tea Party

PSHE:- This week we will be continuing with the topic 'Changing Me'.

At home you could:

- Talk about what you remember from earlier on in your childhood. You could look back at photos of yourself and see what has changed. Perhaps there are photos at home of your parents or even grandparents as children. What is similar and what is different?
- Look at different food in packets and estimate how many of each item there are inside. How many crisps are inside a packet? How many raspberries are inside a packet? Can you carefully count to see if you're correct?
