**Phonics:-** We will continue revising the phonemes and tricky words we have learnt this year. We will also learn to spell the tricky words water, where, who, work, again, any, many, please, as well as segmenting polysyllabic words.

**DT:-** This week we will be learning about why we need to wash our hands before handling food. We will also learn the different food groups and know what a healthy/balanced meal consists of. We will end the week by making scones, fruit kebabs and sandwiches ready for the Grandparents on Friday.

**History:-** We will be exploring the differences between the past and the present. We will be exploring different toys, looking at what they are made of and comparing them to our own toys.
