Dear Parent/Carer,

English - In English this week children will become authors. The children will be writing their own fiction or non-fiction books. The children will include: a front cover, a blurb, conjunctions, contractions, suffixes and punctuation.

Maths - In Maths this week we will be revising some of the topics we have covered this year. For example: addition, subtraction, division, multiplication, 2D/3D shape, money, fractions and time. The children will be applying their knowledge to a range of independent challenges.

At home you could revise telling the time with your child to the nearest 5 and 15 minute intervals.

Music - This week we will be finishing our rehearsals for our Y2 play 'There's a sunflower in my supper' ready for our first performance, whilst also preparing for our Leaver's Assembly.

Please ensure all costumes for 'There's a sunflower in my supper' are on your child's peg in a named bag by Friday 12th July. If you have any problems, please see your child's class teacher.

PSHE - We will be continuing to work on transition to the next school this week. We will be discussing things we are excited and nervous about. We will also begin reflecting on our time at Manby Lodge.

Spelling - Last week was the children's last spelling check. This is because the end of year play and leavers assembly rehearsals are in full swing and as we approach the end of term it is getting very busy with transition activities. Thank you for your support this year with the children's weekly spellings.

Homework changes - Children are now expected to complete either ONE Maths or English activity EACH WEEK (from the homework grid) to bring in to school on a FRIDAY. This can be completed on paper or in their homework books. The Topic tasks are additional. This will be shared with the class each Friday and stamped by the teacher.

Reading - Please read with your child every night for 10 minutes and ask them questions about the book.
