

**Our focus this week:-** We will continue to talk to the children about looking after the environment by using the vocabulary reduce, reuse and recycle. We will be talking about transition to year one. We are also looking forward to Sports Day on Thursday.

**Maths:-** We will be practising our counting and addition skills, playing board games to help us solve problems.

**Literacy:-** We will continue to share and talk about well known fairy tales, such as The Three Bears, The Gingerbread Man and Jack and the Beanstalk. We will be retelling these stories in our own words. We will be using our story corners, small worlds and role plays to tell stories. We will be making posters to educate people about recycling and plastic pollution.

**Phonics:-** In phonics we will be continuing work on phase 4 which incorporates phase 2 and phase 3 phonemes, digraphs and trigraphs which we have already learnt. We will continue to practise the tricky words: **I, no, go, to, the, he, she, we, be, me, you, they, all, was, my, they, said, so, have, like, some, come.** We will be counting syllables in words.

**At home you could:-** Play number games such as hopscotch, skittles, snakes and ladders, connect four.
