Dear Parents and Carers,

English: The children will start the week by writing a recount of their school trip to Painshill Park on Monday. Later in the week, they will create eye-catching posters to advertise their end of term parties. They will also be preparing for Year 2 by writing letters to their new teachers and using ambitious adjectives to describe when writing acrostic poems using names of their new classes (Leopards, Lions & Tigers).

Phonics: Children will be taking part in lots of fun games and activities that will help them to recap the Phase 5 phonemes as well as the Year 1 Common Exception words.

Maths: In Maths we will be continuing with the topic of time. Children will recap telling the time to o'clock and will begin to learn to tell the time to half past the hour.

PSHE: In preparation for their transition to Year 2, the children will use circle time to share their thoughts and feelings about the year ahead.

Art: Children will be creating a collaborative collage of their new class animal to take up to their new classroom. They will also be creating a final self-portrait that they will compare to the portraits that they created at the beginning of the year.

PE: Children will take part in a range of coordination and team building skills using their bodies and various pieces of equipment.

At home you could: Talk to your child about how they are feeling about moving to Year 2. Support your child's time telling by regularly using an analogue clock at various times throughout the day.
