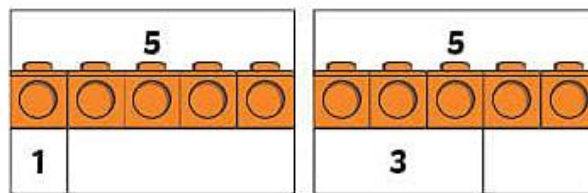
Dear Parents and Carers,

English: This week we will be reading the story 'Supertato' by Paul Linnet and Sue Hendra. Although we are so grateful for your enthusiasm we politely ask that you do not read the text beforehand in order to make the learning as exciting as possible.

Phonics: We will be looking at the following sounds next week ir, ue, ar, wh and ph. Please do look at your key ring and practise these new sounds at home.

Maths: We will be looking at number bonds to and within ten as well as introducing bar models.



Geography: We will be looking at the different types of houses in Weybridge. Please could your child bring in a photo of your house to share with the class next week.

Art: We will create our own Picasso inspired portraits using watercolours.

PSHE: We will continue to learn the language used in the Zones of Regulation and encourage the children to use their photograph on our class displays to demonstrate how they are feeling.

At home you could:

- Go for a walk around your local area and have a look at the different types of houses and discuss the different features of them such as doors, chimneys and windows.
- Try to find your new phonemes within some books at home. Can you make a list of these words?
