Roald Dahl - *Sharing a range of texts by the same author* e.g. The Twits and George's Marvellous Medicine

- Exploring the author's use of characterisation and vocabulary
- Comparing and contrasting texts by the same author
- Experimenting with a range of genres such as recipes and instruction writing, narrative retelling and recount writing.
- Poetry – exploring different poetic techniques to create poems on a theme e.g. Easter, Spring.

PE – Real PE

- Dynamic balancing - co-ordination, balancing in different ways, with a partner, on apparatus, on the floor – using and applying the skills from the previous units to perform sequences to music.

PSHE – Jigsaw – Healthy Me!

- Making healthy lifestyle choices
- Recognising feelings e.g. stress, relaxed
- Identifying and sorting different food groups
- Exploring how medicines work and how to use them safely.

Maths

- Multiplication – repeated addition, arrays, 2x, 5x, 10x and 3x
- doubles, equal groups
- Division – sharing and grouping, odd and even numbers, divide by 2, 5 and 10
- Measurement - length and height – measuring using cms, ms, comparing and ordering lengths and heights and using the 4 operations with length and height.

RE - *Why should we look after our world?*

- Consider why the World is a place of wonder
- Explore how Christians, Jews and Muslims all believe that there is one God who created the world and cares for all people
- Read creation stories from the Bible, the Torah and the Qur'an
- Discuss how some non-religious people believe different things about how the World came to be.

Why is Easter important to Christians?

- Explore the meaning of different Easter symbols
- Recognise and name Easter 'artefacts'

Science – *Plants continued*

- Plan, carry out, and evaluate an investigation into the conditions that affect germination and a plant's growth
- Observe and describe how a plant changes as it matures
- Plant life-cycles
