Dear Parents and Carers,

English:- For the next two weeks we will base all our writing tasks around our transition into year 2. The children will be writing letters to the new class teacher and writing questions to find out about their learning in year 2.

Phonics:- This week we will be reviewing all the alternative sounds taught this term.

Maths:- We will continue to learn about money and will compare notes and coins. We will also start learning about the concept of time and will be learning about the days of the weeks and the months of year.

History:- We will continue finding out about Neil Armstrong's landing on the moon and the impact this had on the world.

Music:- We are performing the song 'your imagination' to each other using musical instruments.

Computing:- We will begin to understand how code executes when a program is run by using the air traffic control game on purple mash.

RE:- We will be consolidating our learning about Judaism and will recap what a Torah is & why is it so important to Jewish families.

P.E:- We will continue to develop our ball skills and ball coordination when passing and throwing the ball.

PSHE:- This week we will be talking about the different changes that can happen in life and how we cope with them. e.g starting school or moving classes.

At home you could:

- Read your reading books - even if it is just for five minutes per day. Remember - reading the same book is a positive thing! It helps to develop fluency and confidence.
- When you go shopping, provide children with opportunities to use coins to buy items.
- Create a little information book about Neil Armstrong's landing on the moon.
