We have had a wonderful week this week writing letters to our friendly skeleton and the children have really enjoyed having their first Forest School lesson.

English: - This week we will be reading the story 'Oliver's vegetables' by Alison Bartlett and Vivian French

Phonics: - We will be recapping the Phase 5 digraphs 'oy', 'ir', 'ue' and 'aw'.

<u>Maths:-</u> We will be counting out different amounts of objects and comparing them using words and symbols e.g.  $\langle , \rangle$ , =, greater than and less than.

<u>Science:-</u> We will continue to look at our senses and will be focusing on touch.

<u>Art:-</u> We will be continuing to practise our shading skills by focusing on our lips and nose and will use these skills in the future to create a portrait.

Geography: - We will be observing human and physical features around school and going for a walk around the school.

Music: - We are learning to play a tuned instrument alongside the song which we are performing.

PSHE: - We will be recognising when we feel proud of ourselves and how it makes us feel.
