Whilst the sky blue polo shirt can be plain or with logo, we recommend you purchase at least one featuring the Manby Lodge logo for school trips/photographs.

**All items of uniform must be clearly named – if items are lost we cannot always return them if there is no name.**

**No jewellery, except earrings should be worn in school, unless the jewellery is for religious reasons. We really discourage parents from sending children to school with earrings, particularly in Year R and Year 1 where children's learning is more active. If your child does have pierced ears, only plain gold or silver metal studs are allowed.**

**When children do PE they should not wear earrings on that day, but may cover them with plasters if it is not possible to remove the studs.**
