# Week commencing 16.10.23

Dear Parents and Carers.

We have had a super busy week being detectives and finding clues to help us find out what happened to the vegetables in our classroom. Children used their clues to create a wanted poster and write up a police report of their findings. In RE we learnt about the creation story and the children recreated their own favourite scenes from the story on a paper plate.

<u>English:-</u> This week we will continue to read the story 'Supertato' by Paul Linnet and Sue Hendra and will be making our own Supertato and using adjectives to describe his characters. We will also be writing speech bubble dialogues between two of the characters from the book.

Phonics: - We will be completing phonics assessments on the Phase 5 sounds which have been recapped this term.

Maths: - We will be continuing with addition and will recap our number bonds within ten.

Geography: - We will be creating our own maths symbols and will be using directional language such as North, East, South, West.

Science: - We will finish our senses topic by focusing on the sense of hearing and will be playing a sound bingo game

<u>PSHE:-</u> We will recap our classroom expectation of being Safe, Ready and Respectful and will be thinking about ways in which we can move around the school safely.

<u>Art:-</u> We will be looking at the artist Pablo Picasso and will be learning to use colours to portray emotions in a portrait.

Music: We will be performing the song 'Hey you!' to each other and will be giving feedback.

#### At home you could:

- Create your own abstract portrait using the style of Pablo Picasso using magazine cut outs.
- Continue reading with your children for 10 minutes a day and recap the sounds taught at the back of their reading records.
- Create your own map of your house with symbols and keys.
