Dear Parents and Carers.

Welcome back! We hope everyone had a great half term! During the last week of term the children had great fun, making their own Supertatoe and wrote a description about him. The children have also enjoyed creating their own Pablo Picasso inspired portraits.

Our new topic for this half term is 'Celebrating Me - Festivals and Celebrations', this will include learning about special celebrations leading up to Christmas as well as looking at toys from the past in history.

<u>English:</u> This week we will be reading the story 'Sparks in the Sky' and will be writing our own captions. We will be talking about the difference between questions and statements and will be learning to punctuate correctly.

Phonics: We will continue to review phase 5 sounds and will recap au (pause), ey (money), a_e and e_e.

<u>History:</u> We will be learning about Guy Fawkes and why we celebrate Bonfire Night and we will also be introducing our history topic 'Toys from the Past'. Children will have an opportunity to share one of their favourite toys with their class on Friday for "Show and Tell"; please make sure you do not send in any valuable items.

Maths: We will continue to focus on addition using the + and = symbols and will be introducing word problems.

<u>Science</u>: We will be looking at the changes in the weather during the autumn seasons and will be talking about changes we have come across so far e.g getting colder so we are wearing our hats and gloves.

DT: We will learn about moving pictures and will be making our own sliding pictures.

<u>PSHE:</u> This week we will be looking at differences that might not be visible, for example, likes, hobbies, etc. We will discuss how our differences make us unique and that it is okay for everybody to be different.

At home you could:

- Please continue to read with your child for 10 minutes every day and remember to also write in their reading records.
- Continue recapping the phonics sounds using the booklets at the back of your reading records.
- Create your own 3D firework pictures using different coloured items in the house.
- Research about Guy Fawkes and create your own fact file about him.
