Dear Parents and Carers.

What a busy week it's been! The children have been thrilled to finally perform their nativity to their grown-ups and have loved making their own Christmas nativity scene, stained glass windows in RE. In English the children have been creating their own Christmas poem using the story 'Katie's London Christmas' as inspiration.

English: We will be reading the story 'Cookie's Christmas Invention' and will be designing our own machine to help Santa deliver presents. We will also be writing a letter to Santa to tell him about our new invention.

Phonics: We will be recapping all the sounds we have been learning this term. The children will be reading and writing words and sentences using these sounds. We will also be continuing to conduct an end of term phonics assessment with the children.

Maths: We will be recapping 2D and 3D shapes and will be using shapes to create a Christmas picture.

Christmas Activities: We have a number of different Christmas related activities planned for the children next week so please make a note of the days and what your children will need to bring along.

Monday: Children are in for a special treat as they will have an opportunity to watch a pantomime in school.

- Find different 2D and 3D items in the house and try and sort them into different groups based on their properties.
