Areas of Strength:

PSHE Development

Impact:

- Training for staff, to include values, active learning, ground rules, question walls.
- Infant focussed needs.

Collaborative working with Staff

Impact:

- Working alongside PE lead.
- Development of active learning and physical activity.

Development of Lunchtime supportive approaches Impact:

- Lunchtime activity stations.
- Wellbeing work with lunchtime staff.
- Improved lunchtime behaviour.
- Play trained lunchtime supervisors.
- Quiet room at breaktime for SEN pupils who find the playground overwhelming.
- Mindfulness on return from breaks to bridge the active body to calmer learning ensuring calmer starts to work.

Wellbeing

Impact:

- Surveys ensure work time is smarter and staff meetings focus on needs and give staff more time for other work opportunities.
- Well Being Lead Teacher regularly with Head Teacher to ensure feedback is up to date and situations discussed are current and appropriate.
- Establishment of a well being working party made up of staff across a wide section of the school, Support staff, teaching staff, admin staff and catering staff.
