

English: - The children will look at examples of non-fiction texts about animals. We will examine all the different features that they have (contents, pictures, titles, glossary etc.) and compare these to fiction books. They will then research rhinos and giraffes and create information posters about these animals.

Phonics: - This week the children will look at some alternative graphemes. These will include:

/t/ spelled te e.g. route, paste, taste

/or/ spelled ar e.g. warm, swarm, warning

/or/ spelled oar e.g. oar, roar, soar

/or/ spelled oor e.g. floor, door, doorbell

Maths: - This week the children will begin to learn about time. We will initially think about things you do at different times of the day and sequence these. We will then move on to looking at the days of the week and months of the year, the order they come in and which days come before and after each other. They will then move on to understanding hours, minutes and seconds and comparing how long different activities take.

Art: - The children will create their own clay sculptures this week using techniques they have practised.

History: - This week the children will be introduced to Tim Peake and explore what different astronauts do.

Music: - The children will compose their own melodies and then try to play these over their new lyrics.

Computing: - This week the children will create their own background for a computer game and then code simple characters within the game.

Science: - This week the children will explore the similarities and differences between carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

PSHE: - The children will think about how every time they learn something new they change a little bit.

RE: - We will think about all the stories we have learnt about this term and what they have taught us.
