<u>Literacy</u> - In Literacy this week we will be continuing reading the story 'The Extraordinary Gardener' by Sam Boughton. The children will be considering the terms ordinary and extraordinary and using their imagination to explore ways to transform an ordinary object into an extraordinary object and writing about it. We are looking forward to finding out about their ideas. We have been really impressed with their ideas so far.

<u>Maths</u> -We will be reviewing formation of our numbers up to 20 and creating our own number lines. The children will be using mathematical equipment to represent the numbers and writing our own number lines up to 10 and 20.

Music - We will be practising and singing the Big Bear Funk leading up to a mini performance for their peers.
