

English: - This week we continue to be detectives and will be using adjectives to create a wanted poster for our mystery culprit.

Phonics: - We will be recapping the following sounds /oy/, /ir/, /ue/ and /aw/ as well as the harder to read and spell words the children learnt in reception.

Maths: - We will be looking at one less than numbers up to 10. As well as this we will compare groups of objects using the language more and fewer.

Science: - We will learn about our sense of touch. The children will be exploring different textures and materials and describing them.

Music: - Listen and appraise the song 'Can't Touch This' by MC Hammer and use glockenspiels to try to play along to Hey You.

PSHE: - We will talk about how our feelings change when we have to face certain consequences.

Geography: - We will be learning what human and physical features are and will be sorting pictures of them into different groups.

Computing: - We will be continuing to look at sorting objects and will be completing a sorting task on Purple Mash.
