



Dear Parents/Carers,

English - This week we will be reading the story 'The Storm Whale' by Benji Davies. We will be making predictions, sequencing the text and writing instructions of how to look after a whale!

Maths - In maths the children will look at numbers on a numberline up to 100. They will also estimate where to put these numbers on a numberline. We will then compare the numbers using the symbols <, > and =.

Art - In our art this week the children will experiment with different joining techniques in preparation for making sculptures.

Geography - The children will re-cap their knowledge of the countries of the U.K and their capital cities. They will then look at some of the characteristics of these countries.

PSHE - The children will explain what rights and responsibilities mean.

R.E - This week the children will explore how Muslims get ready to talk to Allah.

Computing - This week the children will explore how being online will leave a digital footprint.

Science - The children will learn what reptiles need to survive.

P.E - This week the children will focus on maintaining their balance while they are on one leg.

Today the children will bring home their green homework books. Spellings for the next few weeks are stuck inside the front cover. Please complete the spelling homework according to the dates on the sheet.

Reading - Please read with your child every night for 10 minutes and ask them questions about the book. Books will continue to be changed by the children on a Friday.
