

English: - This week we will be continued to be inspired by Funnybones and particularly Big Skeleton. Following his visit to school last week we will be helping him get his lost hat back. The children will be identifying different types of communication e.g. text messages, emails and letters. We will look in more detail at letters and the features of them and then write our own letters to Big Skeleton.

Phonics: - We will be revising the following sounds /wh/ /ph/ /ue/ and /oe/ as well as the harder to read and spell words the children learnt in reception.

Maths: - We will be continuing to compare numbers using the language greater than, less than and equal to as well as the symbols < > and =. The children will also be introduced to number lines to ten.

Science: - We will be looking at the changes we notice in the environment during the Autumn season.

Geography: - We will be going for our local area walk. We will look at any human and physical features we see.

Art: - This week we will be creating our collage backgrounds for our Brianna McCarthy inspired portraits.

PSHE: - In PSHE this week we will re-cap the Zones of Regulation with the children. We will explore what it feels like to be in each zone and discuss how this may change throughout the day.

Computing: - The children will continue to practise logging in to Purple Mash using their individual user name and password.

At home you could:

- Use Google Earth to look at school and see what things you can spot in the local area human & physical
- Ensure your child is confident to use their username and password for Purple Mash (see note below).
- Read with your children for 10mins every day and write in their reading records.
