
<u>English: - In our English lessons this week we will be looking at poetry.</u> The children will explore different poems and describe how they make them feel. We will then move on to looking at autumn inspired poems and use our senses to write our own autumn poems.

Phonics: - We will be revising the following sounds we have been learning this term

Maths: - We will be beginning to look at part part whole models and how to write number sentences.



<u>Computing:</u> We will continue to practise logging onto purple mash and will explore a range of simple activities.

<u>Geography: -</u> We will be looking at the different types of homes in the UK and will be talking about similarities and differences. <u>Science:</u> We will continue to observe the changes in the environment during the autumn season and will be creating an autumn tree display in our classroom.
