Dear Parents and Carers,

Phonics - This week we will be learning the digraph 'h, b, ff, ll' and we will be assessing the children's phonic knowledge on the sounds taught so far this term. We will also be introducing the harder to read and spell word: as and his. Please practise these at home.

Literacy - In Literacy this week we will be sharing the text 'Room on the Broom'. We will be encouraging the children to sequence the main parts of the story and also label the main characters using their sounds. During the week we will be creating a WANTED poster for the Witch.

Music - We will be learning to the piece Sing by the Carpenters and listening to different sounds made by music. The children will be talking about how different music makes us feel.

Maths - We will be reinforcing the children's understanding of cardinality (that the last number in the count tells us 'how many' things there are altogether in a set of objects). They will practise their 1:1 correspondence skill by counting numbers at the same time. The children will deepen their understanding of 5 as a quantity by linking the number itself to 5 fingers on one hand and begin exploring ways to represent numbers to 5 using both their fingers and the Hungarian number pattern.

Art - We will be exploring the basics of colour mixing this week and experimenting with the colours red and yellow.
