Week commencing 17.11.2025

<u>English: -</u> This week we will continue reading the story 'Lost at the Toy Museum'. We will sequence the story and have a go at retelling it. We will also practise our non-fiction writing skills by writing a recount of our toy workshop.

<u>Phonics: -</u> We will be revising the following sounds /y/ as in pharmacy and city and /al/ as in walk and wall. As well as the new harder to read and spell words who and whole.

<u>Maths:</u> Our focus will be on addition this week. We will begin by adding two numbers together then adding more. Following this, we will introduce the children to addition problems e.g. first there were 3 children on the bus then 2 more got on. How many children are on the bus now? We will also be finding parts of part whole models.

<u>Science: -</u> This week the children will explore the classroom and school to find things made from different materials. They will also then draw and label objects and the materials they are made from.

<u>R.E. -</u> We will discuss why the angels are such an important part of the Nativity story and the message they deliver.

History: - On Tuesday 18th we are looking forward to welcome Mrs Oliphant for our toy workshop.

<u>D&T: -</u> This week we will be looking at leavers, pivots and wheels. The children will create their own picture with moving parts.

<u>Computing: -</u> The children will use 2Count on Purple Mash to create their own pictogram on the Chromebooks.

- Practise your child's lines (if they have any) and the songs for the Christmas performance.
- Practise the songs for the Nativity performance.
- Read with your children for 10mins every day and write in their reading records.
