

English: - This week we will be introducing our new text 'Stickman'. The children will be getting familiar with the text by acting out parts of the story and will be learning about the different story settings. We will also be thinking about how Stick Man felt during the different events within the text.

Phonics: - We will be revising all of the Phase 5 sounds.



Maths: - Our focus will be on subtraction this week and we will be creating our own subtraction stories. We will also be using number lines to complete our subtraction stories.

Science: - This week the children will be learning about melting and freezing and learning to understand that this is a reversible change.

R.E: - We will continue to unpick the nativity story and will look closely at all the important characters.

History: - We will be recapping some of our learning from the toy workshop and will be sorting some old and new toys.

D&T: - We will be designing our moving picture.

PSHE: - The children will discuss what they can do if they feel someone is being bullied.

At home you could:

- Practise your child's lines (if they have any) and the songs for the Christmas performance.
- Practise the songs for the Nativity performance.
- Read with your children for 10mins every day and write in their reading records. If your child is becoming more fluent with their reading spend some time discussing the story (there are often helpful questions inside the covers of the book).
