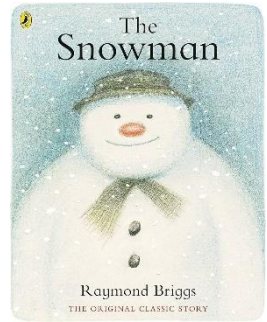


Week beginning: 1.12.2025



Dear Parents/Carers,

This week we will be...

D&T - We will be making our bread!

English - We will be retelling the familiar story of 'The Snowman', then using what we have learned to compare and contrast the book and animation version.

Maths - We will be continuing the topic of Shape, looking at lines of symmetry, sorting 2D shapes and exploring 3D shapes and their properties in more detail.

Computing - We will be learning how to use the 'speak' and 'count' tools on 2Calculate to count items.

History - We will be ordering the events of the Titanic in chronological order.

Music - We will be rehearsing songs for our Christmas nativity production.

RE - We will be further recognising what worship looks like in Christianity, specifically in the church.

Science - We will be testing different materials to see if they can change shape by stretching, squashing, twisting and bending them.

PSHE - We will be recognising that everybody is different.

***In D&T, the children have designed their own bread recipes using two additional ingredients (e.g. honey and raisins, or cheese and garlic). A copy of their plan will be sent home this week. Please could we ask that your child brings the additional ingredients in a named bag by Monday, 1st December* If you have any difficulties purchasing these items, please let your class teacher know.**

***Cardboard Plea* Please could we ask for donations of plain, thin cardboard for our Christmas craft activity- no writing or pictures on either side of the cardboard please. Thank you in advance!**
