Dear Parents/Carers,

This week we will be...

D&T - Exploring different types of bread from around the world.

English - The children will be continuing their learning about poetry. They will read, and respond to a new poem called 'The Sound Collector'.

Maths - We will be continuing our learning on addition and subtraction, looking at adding two 2-digit numbers.

Computing - We will be learning how to add images to a spreadsheet on PurpleMash.
