

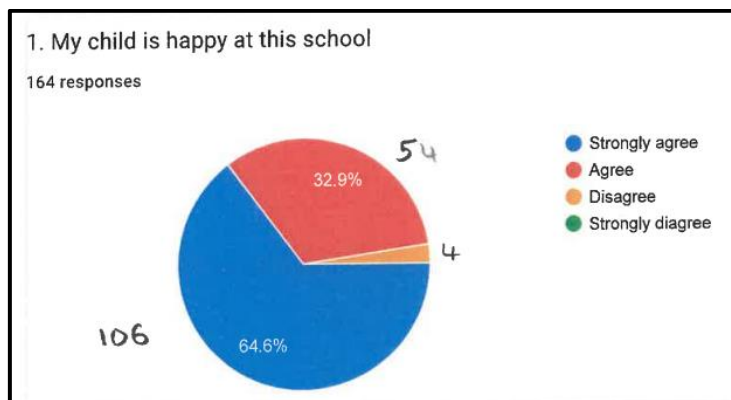
Annual Parent Survey Results and Analysis – Autumn 2025

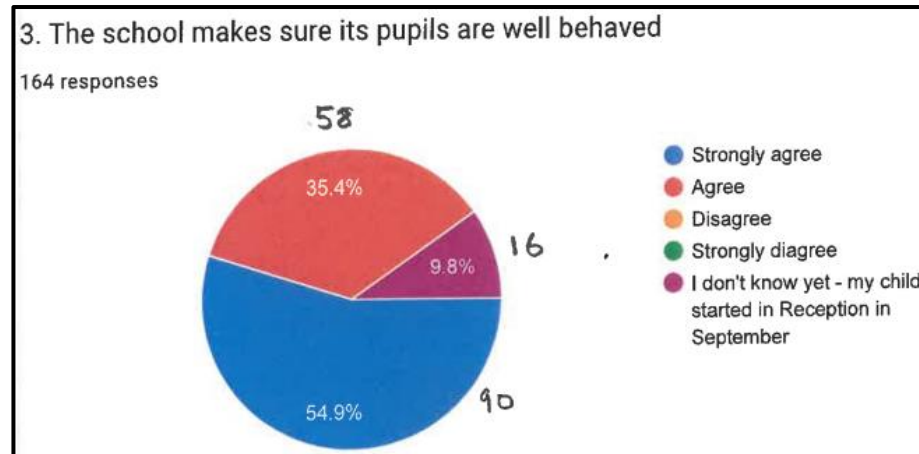
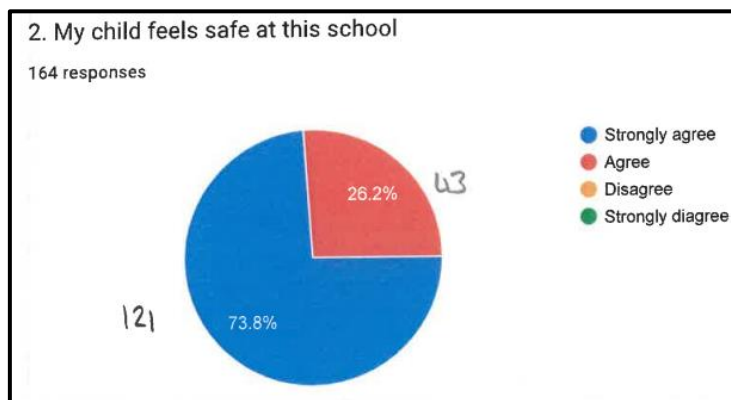
There are a few points that we would like to follow up on. We have added these after the questions where we think it was necessary to do so.

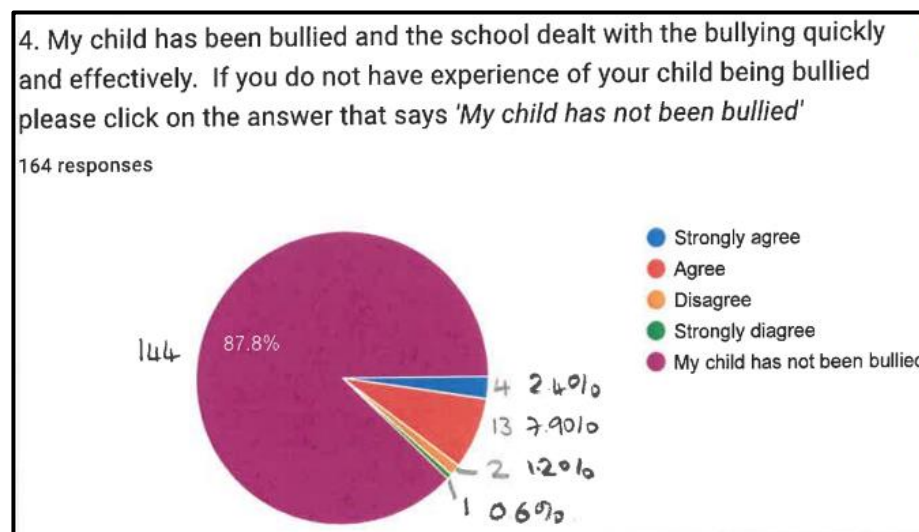

This question shows an improvement since last year – no parents disagreed with this question.

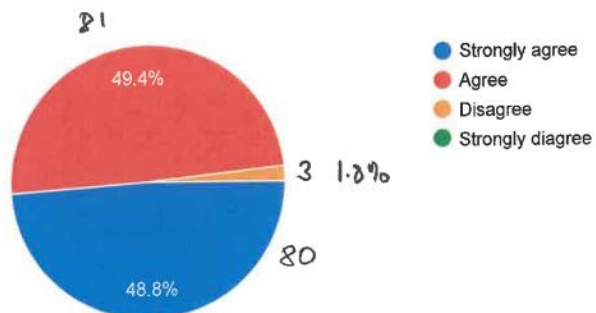


As always more parents answered 'yes, my child has been bullied' when we compare this to the number of bullying allegations we have had over the last few years. We keep records as staff must record and investigate all allegations of bullying. We are pleased that most parents report that we have dealt with the situation quickly and effectively. Bullying can happen anywhere, and it does happen at Manby Lodge. If you think that your child is being bullied **it is essential that you speak to a member of staff**, and together, decide about next steps.

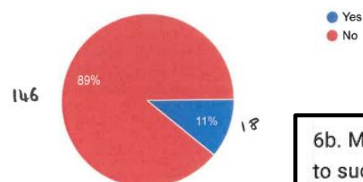
5. The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year

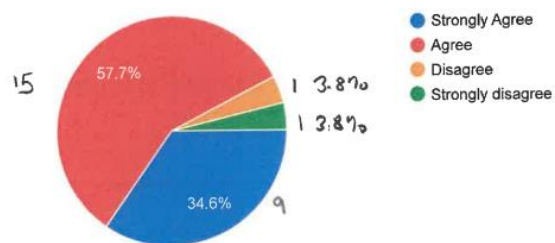
6a. Does your child have special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND)?

6b. My child has SEND, and the school gives them the support they need to succeed

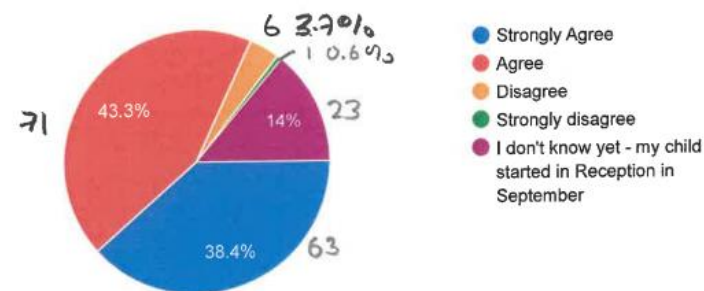

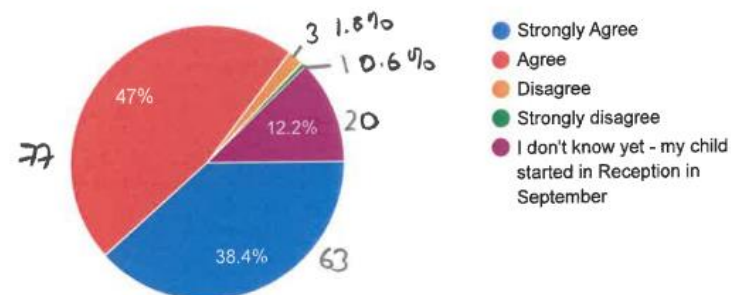
7. The school has high expectations for my child

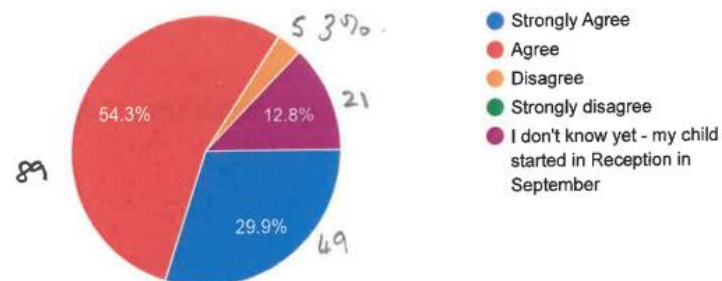
8. My child does well at this school

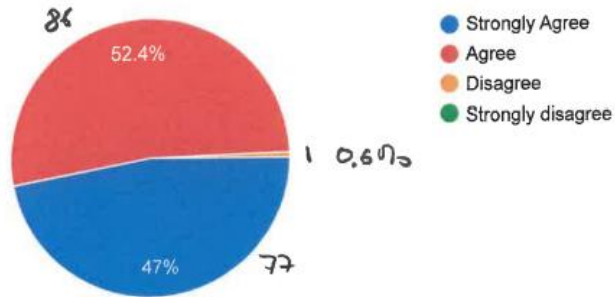
9. The school lets me know how my child is doing

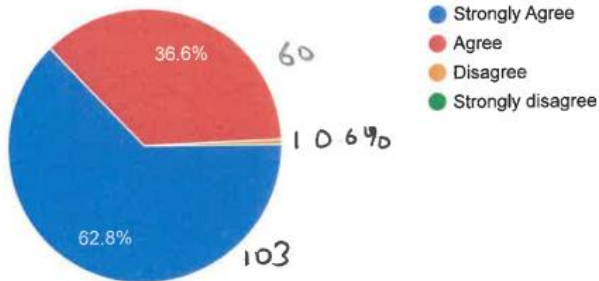
10. There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school

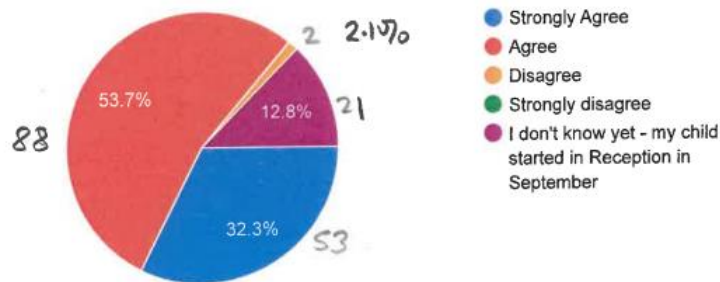
11. My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school

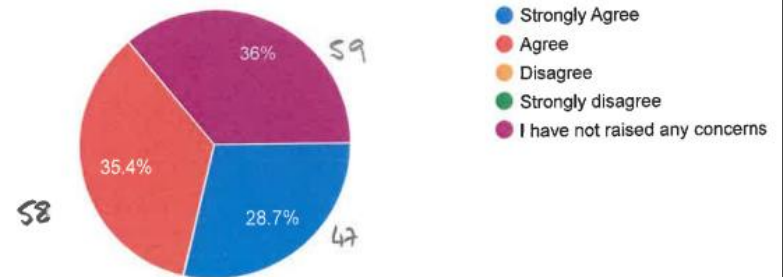
12. The school supports my child's wider personal development

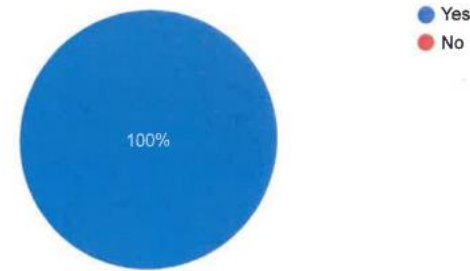
13. When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly

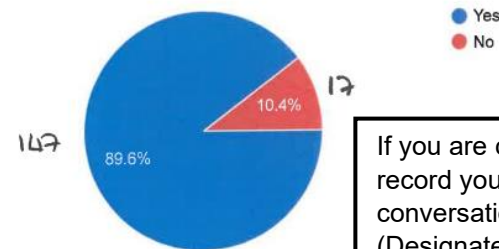
14. I would recommend this school to another parent
