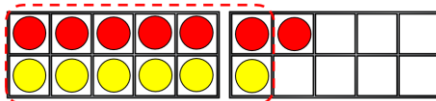


Dear Parents and Carers,

English: - This week we will be creating fact files about different types of transport we saw at Brooklands Museum.

Phonics: - We will be revising all the sounds they have learnt so far and will be checking which sounds are harder to read and spell words they do and don't know. This will be instead of reading with the children.

Maths: - We will be looking at finding doubles and near doubles and using this to help us add 2 numbers.

Science: - We will be looking at wild flowers and garden plants and will be drawing our own gardens containing them.

Geography: - We will be locating the UK using globes, maps and atlas.
