

Dear Parents and Carers,

English: - This week we will be looking at the difference between fiction and non-fiction writing as well as writing our own questions to ask the experts on our trip to Brooklands Museum. This will all feed into our non-fiction writing the week after.

Phonics: - We will continue learning new alternative sounds:

/ur/ spelled: or e.g. world, work, ear e.g. pearl, earnings.

/oo/ spelled ou e.g. soup, coupon

/oa/ spelled oul e.g. shoulder, poultry

/ee/ spelled ie e.g. shield, field

/v/ spelled ve e.g. curve, serve

/i/ spelled y e.g. cygnet, sycamore

Maths: - We will be comparing and ordering numbers to 20 and will be building on our learning of addition by counting on within 20.

Music: - We will be looking at a new song 'Banana Rap' and changing the pitch of our voices to match the pitch of the song.

Art: - The children will sketch out and paint the background of their final landscape piece.

Science: - This week, we will understand that deciduous trees lose their leaves in autumn and name and identify examples of evergreen trees such as holly and pine.

Geography: - We will be learning that continents are made up of different countries.

R.E: - Following our visit from North West Surrey Synagogue last week we will discuss where the Torah is kept and how this shows its importance.

PSHE: - The children will recognise that new learning may stretch them and identify how they feel when they are faced with new learning.
