

Week beginning: 05.01.2026



Dear Parents/Carers,

Happy New Year and welcome back! We hope you all had a lovely Christmas break and return well rested and ready to go for the spring term.

English - In English this week we will be focussing on the text, Little Rabbit Foo Foo by Michael Rosen. Children will be reading and responding to the story, sharing their likes and dislikes and exploring patterns within the text. As a class, we will be creating a story-map to enable the children to retell the story using actions to support. We will also be looking closely at the author's use of vocabulary and its meaning.

Maths - In maths the children will be learning about money. Children will begin by recapping the value of all of the coins. Later in the week, they will solve addition and subtraction problems. This will include using their knowledge of counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to solve problems.

History - We will be beginning our new focus in history and beginning our learning about Florence Nightingale, a significant figure in history. We will be looking at pictorial sources and finding out what the children already know and what they would like to find out about her.

PSHE - In PSHE we will be beginning our topic on Dreams and Goals this week. The children will be thinking about a goal / wish they want to set themselves in school and considering what they will need to help them to achieve it.

Science - In Science we will explore a wide range of plants.

RE - We will be learning what an expert or a guide is.

Computing - This week we will be presenting ideas in a non-fiction fact file based on Florence Nightingale.

Music - We will be appraising and learning the song 'I wanna be in a band', and identifying the pulse in a piece of music.

Reading - Please read with your child every night for 10 minutes and ask them questions about the book. Books will continue to be changed by the children on a Friday.

Please note, Multi-Sports will move to a Thursday morning this half term to replace Forest School. Therefore, please ensure that children have an appropriate winter kit in school ready.
