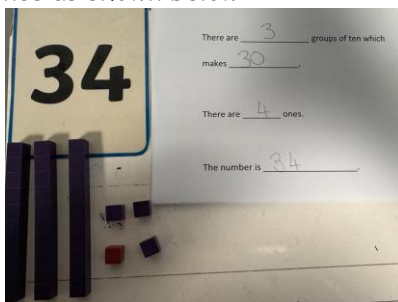


Dear Parents and Carers,

**English:** - This week the children will begin to explore the Great Fire of London in our English lessons. They will compare what London was like in 1666 and what it is like today using the conjunctions and, but, so or because.

**Phonics:** - The children will learn the alternative grapheme o making the /u/ sound e.g. son, honey, brother and revising all of the alternative graphemes we have learnt so far.

**Maths:** - The children will be introduced to counting in groups of 10 and numbers up to 50. Children will then practically make 2 digit numbers using dienes as shown below:



**Music:** - The children will listen to How Blue Can You Get? By Bebe King and share their thoughts on the piece of music.

**Science:** - The children will be thinking about caring for our planet and comparing what will happen if we do not look after our planet.

**History:** - We will start our new topic about the Great Fire of London and will be learning about when and where the fire started.

**RE:** - We will be starting our unit on Christianity and will be thinking about what Christians learn from stories of Jesus?
