Phonics - This week we will be reviewing all the sounds we have learnt so far, we are also reviewing all harder to read and spell words, please practice these at home.

Literacy - In Literacy this week we will be reading the story 'Whatever Next' by Jill Murphy. The children are writing crime reports in provision. We are also working on letter formation of l, i, t in trays of rice or cornflour.

Maths - We will be exploring and comparing mass and capacity. We will look at capacity in our water area, and mass on our maths table with weighing scales.
