



Dear Parents and Carers,

Phonics - This week we will continue to review all the sounds learned so far. We will also review the HRSWs: *the, to, was, said, my, so, have* and *one*. Please practise these at home.

Literacy - In Literacy we will be reading 'Superworm' by Julia Donaldson. The book links nicely to our new topic this half term of 'Superheroes'. Our role-play will turn into a 'Superhero Headquarters' for the children to role-play and act our stories that we will share. This week the children are writing captions and sentences about Superworm using vocabulary learned from the story.

Maths - We will be finding, representing and looking at how we can make numbers up to 8. The children will be forming the numbers, looking at different representations of the numbers and exploring number sentences (calculations).

Understanding the World - Our role play area will turn into a Superhero HQ! We will expand the children's knowledge and vocabulary of how superheroes come to the rescue and what that looks like. They have all loved using their imagination so far.

Fine Motor - This week we will be using the playdough to make the character of Superworm. We will be linking this to our previous Maths learning by experimenting with making longer and shorter worms, focusing on hand eye coordination.
