- Spell Year 1 common exception words.
- Evaluate my own writing.

Reading

- Use age appropriate non-fiction to extract information.
- Make simple predictions supported by evidence.
- Read unfamiliar words by applying knowledge of alternative graphemes.
- Read more complex words with contractions.
- Discuss reading preferences.

Handwriting

- With a good level of consistency, start and finish letters in the right place.
